Slovak Agricultural Library

is the central library of the Slovak University of Agriculture in Nitra (SUA). It also performs some functions of special scientific library in the field of agriculture and related fields of science. Library offers services for SUA students and staff, for other universities and secondary schools students, for agriculture specialists and public.



History and nowadays

- 1946** - Central Library of University of Agricultural and Forestry Engineering establishing in Košice
- 1951** - Library separation from the University in Košice
- 1952** - Part of Library holdings and equipment delimitation to Nitra, State Studying Library in Nitra establishing with 13 000 volumes holdings
- 1954** - Renaming to State Scientific Library in Nitra, merging with University Library in Bratislava
- 1959** - Renaming to Central Agricultural Library in Nitra, delegation of new function – central library of national agricultural libraries network
- 1960** - Separation from University Library in Bratislava, merging with Agricultural University as special scientific library and central academic library
- 1966** - Starting of participation on Czechoslovak Agricultural Bibliography (library prepared bibliographic records of Slovak documents, the cooperation finished after the Czechoslovakia split in 1993)
- 1975** - Starting with library agenda automation (use of mainframe computers)
- 1991** - Renaming to Slovak Agricultural Library
- 1995** - Launching automated circulation system
- 1996** - The first library web page
- 1999** - The first online full text database (EBSCO Publishing).
- 2004** - Digital archive establishing
- 2009** - Finishing new building reconstruction for the Library

- 11 databases (full text and bibliographic/bibliometric)
 - PCs, scanners, power outlets for personally owned devices.

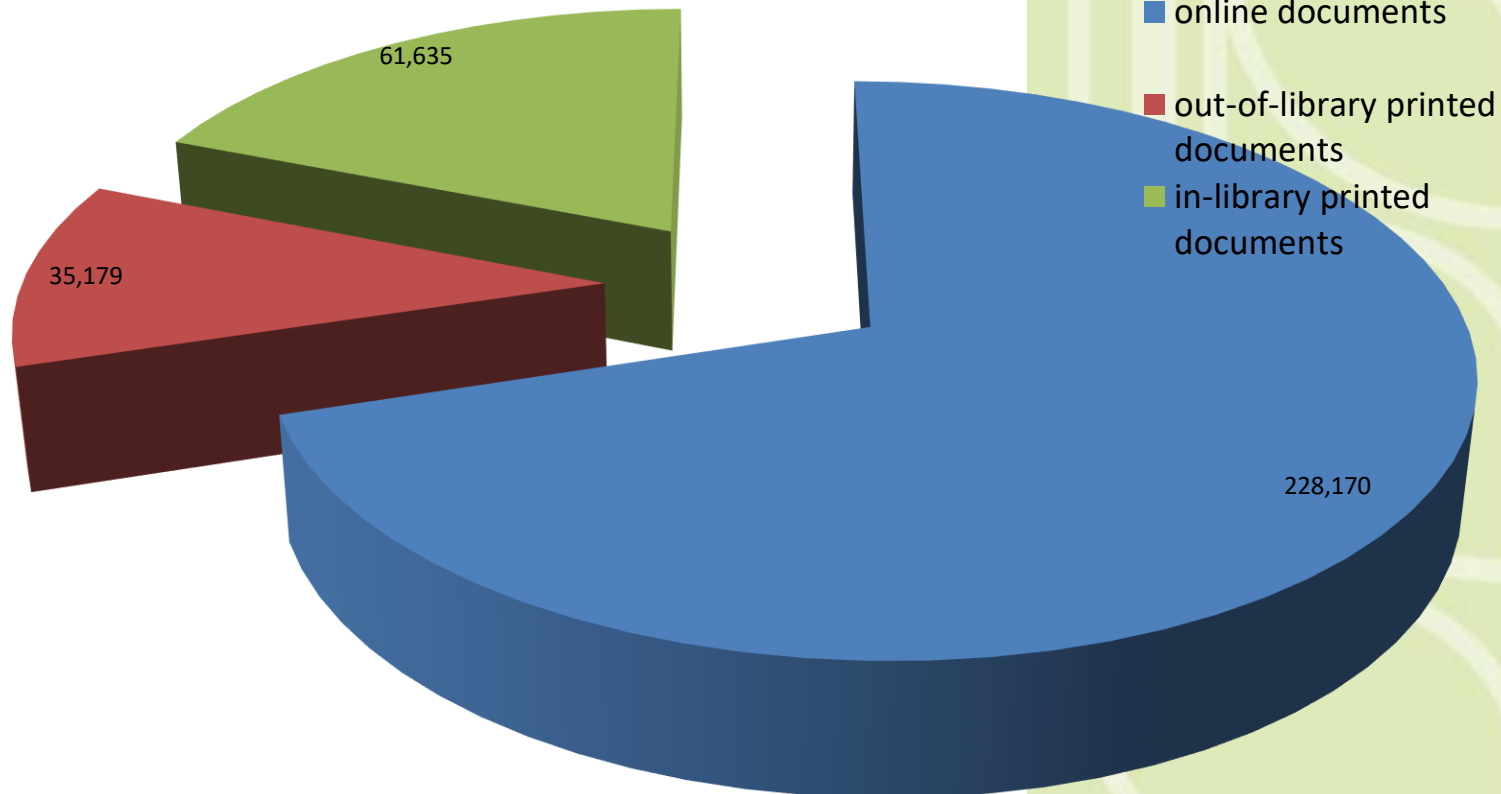
